## **National Provident Fund Act**

### Act 4 of 1971

#### Notes:

- 1. The funds remaining in the National Provident Fund immediately before the coming into operation of this Act shall stand transferred to the Seychelles Pension Fund.
- 2. Any person who satisfies the Chief Executive Officer that the person has not been refunded his contributions by the National Provident Fund shall be entitled to be paid such contributions by the Chief Executive Officer provided that a claim for such payment is submitted to the Chief Executive Officer no later than 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006.
