**AN ACT to amend the Seychelles Bureau of Standards Act
(Cap 212).**

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Seychelles Bureau of Standards (Amendment) Act, 2016. Short title

Amendment
of Cap 212

2. The Seychelles Bureau of Standards Act is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) in section 2, by inserting, after the definition of “conformity assessment” the following definition—
- ““Deputy Chief Executive Officer” means the Deputy Chief Executive Officer appointed under section 11A.”;
- (b) by repealing subsection (3) of section 11;
- (c) by inserting after section 11, the following section—

Appointment
and function
of Deputy
Chief
Executive
Officer

“**11A.**(1) The President may appoint a person who the President considers is suitably qualified in science and technology relevant to the functions of the Bureau and experienced to be Deputy Chief Executive Officer on such terms and conditions as the President may determine.

(2) The Deputy Chief Executive Officer may act in the office of the Chief Executive Officer—

- (a) during the vacancy in the office of the Chief Executive Officer; or
- (b) during any period in which the Chief Executive Officer is absent from duty for any reason or is unable to perform the functions of that office; and
- (c) perform such other functions as the Chief Executive Officer may delegate.”
