1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the Road Transport (One way Streets) Order, 1979.

2. Prohibition on use of streets

The driving of vehicles on—

- (a) the street between the Place de la Republique and Independence Avenue, alongside the Pirates Arms; and
- (b) the street between the Place de la Republique Independence Avenue by way of the Supreme Court, is prohibited except from when driving Independence Avenue to the Place de la Republique.
