These Rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Term) Rules.

2.

- (1) Notwithstanding section 4 of the Seychelles Code of Civil Procedure, there shall be 3 terms in each year for civil business in the Supreme Court—
 - (a) 10th January to 31st March;
 - (b) 1st of May to 31st July; and
 - (c) 15th September to 10th December.
- (2)
 - (a) If the day for the start of a term falls on a *dies non* the term shall commence on the next following day which is not itself a *dies non*.
 - (b) If the day for the end of a term falls on a *dies non* the term shall end on the next preceding day which is not itself a *dies non*.
