**Prevention of Drug Abuse and Rehabilitation Agency
(Term of office, Salary and Allowances of Vice-
Chairperson, Members, Chief Executive Officer, Deputy
Chief Executive Officer and qualifications of Vice-
Chairperson) Regulations, 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 read with sections 6 and 9 of Prevention of Drug Abuse and Rehabilitation Agency Act, 2017 the President hereby makes the following regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prevention of Drug Abuse and Rehabilitation Agency (Term of office, Salary and Allowances of Vice-Chairperson, Members, Chief Executive Officer, Deputy Chief Executive Officer and qualifications of Vice-Chairperson) Regulations, 2018.

Citation

2. The Vice-Chairperson shall be a person knowledgeable in matters related to the Prevention of Drug Abuse and Rehabilitation and has experience in administration, finance, law or management.

3. The Vice-Chairperson and members referred to section 6(1) (o) to (t) of the Act shall be appointed for a term of 3 years and shall be eligible for reappointment.

4. The monthly remuneration of the Vice-Chairperson shall be SCR 3,430 and the members referred to section 6(1) (o) to (t) of the Act shall be SCR 3,048.

5.(1) The salary of the Chief Executive Officer shall be a sum specified at step 15 of salary band 12 of the Public Service Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013.

(2) The Chief Executive Officer shall also be paid an inducement allowance of SCR5,000 and transport allowance of SCR5,600.

(3) The salary of the Deputy Chief Executive Officer shall be a sum specified at step 6 of salary band 11 of the Public Service Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013.

(4) The Deputy Chief Executive Officer shall also be paid an inducement allowance of SCR3,000 and transport allowance of SCR3,000.

6. The President may terminate the appointment of the Vice-Chairperson who—

- (a) has been found guilty of misconduct, default or breach of trust in the discharge of duty;
- (b) has been convicted of an offence and sentenced to imprisonment for a term of three months or more;
- (c) is mentally or physically incapable of carrying out the functions under the Act; or
- (d) has been absent from three consecutive meetings without the permission of the Chairperson.
