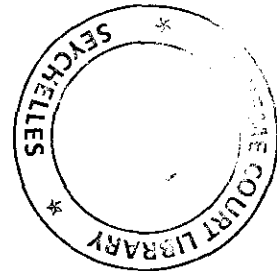

No order as to costs. Reasons will be given later.


