The plaintiff sues the defendant for recovery of the sum of Rs.55,000 which the defendant undertook to p on or before 31 St December 2005 upon an "acknowledgment of debt" dated 17 th March 2005. Notice of the pla was served on the defendant for appearance in Court on 2 nd May 2006. However as he defaulted appearance, to case was fixed for exparte hearing on 12 th June 2006.
On 12 th June 2006, the defendant was absent and unrepresented. Learned Counsel for the plain produced the said "acknowledgement of debt" and submitted that no payment has been made so far.
