The application for bail made by counsel for the defence, Mr. Herminie, on behalf of the accused is hereby granted on the following conditions:

- 1. The accused should enter a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 15, 000/- with two sureties to be approved by the Court and EACH one of them to sign a bond in the same amount.
- 2. The accused should attend Court as ordered.
- 3. The accused should not interfere with the witnesses or the course of justice in this case in any way or get involved in any criminal activity.
- 4. If any of these conditions are breached this order for bail will be revoked and the accused will be remanded in custody.
