**ORDER**

***Gaswaga, J***

This was an application for leave to proceed with a petition filed by Fifco (Offshore) Services Ltd for certain orders including a Writ of Certiorari. It was an *ex parte* matter and it came before the Supreme Court by way of judicial review. During the hearing but at the end of Mr. Boulle’s submissions, State Counsel, Mr. Jude Bonte, who had prosecuted the same before the Court below, pursuant to Rule 7 of SI 40 of 1995, applied to Court for time to file objections to the same.

I have heard the submissions by Mr. Boulle. I have also perused the petition filed as well as the accompanying affidavits.
