The prosecution has asked that bail conditions be imposed on the accused and the conditions are


as follows:-

- [1] The accused shall sign a bail bond in the sum of SR40,000/- (Forty Thousand Rupees) this is to ensure that the accused attends Court each day the she is requested to do so and should the accused at any time fail to appear before Court without a valid excuse, then the accused will have to pay the SR40,000/- into Court.
- [2] The accused shall surrender her passport or any travel documents that she may have to the Registrar of the Supreme Court not later than tomorrow the 24th of June 2021 at 12noon,

and the Immigration Authorities are advised not to issue the accused with any passport or any travel documents and to prevent her from leaving the Republic.

- [3] The accused shall not interfere with witnesses or the due process of proceedings in this case.
- [4] The accused shall report to the Perseverance Police Station at least one a week and that will be every Friday.
